Marvetta Sciuto, Chair of the Maui Center for the American Orchid Society Judging, will be recounting her trip to the World Orchid Conference in Guayaquil, Ecuador, that was held on November 8–12, 2017. The theme of the 22nd Conference was, "A Privileged Orchid Kingdom" which reflects Ecuador's background of being home to about 4,235 species of orchids, with about 1,000 more orchids awaiting official recognition. The conference hoped to inspire young scientists to focus on "developing sustainable models for a productive natural resource management that promotes orchid conservation nationally and globally."

Maryetta will also expound on her Ecuagenera Orchid Tour which allowed her to visit areas in Ecuador where orchids are growing in the wild.
